A New Book and New Shops!

Members Virginia Bayer and Donna Ghelerter have recently published *Marguerita Mergentime: American Textiles, Modern Ideas*. With essays by Donna Ghelerter, editor, Virginia Bayer and Linda Florio, and a foreword by Madelyn Shaw, the book highlights the life and career of textile designer Marguerita Mergentime (1894–1941). Working in the heady milieu of 1930s New York, Mergentime became best known for strikingly new printed fabrics, making her mark with tablecloths created to enliven American households with color, humor, and entertainment.

Marguerita Mergentime: American Textiles, Modern Ideas serves as a definitive source on this lauded American designer. Essays highlight Mergentime's life and career, and over 150 images illustrate her designs that brought asymmetry, politics, folk art, typography, and quizzes to the table. *Marguerita Mergentime: American Textiles, Modern Ideas* reintroduces the woman who asked, "Are you allergic to meaningless uninspired patterns in printed cloths?" and places her squarely back on the scene.
